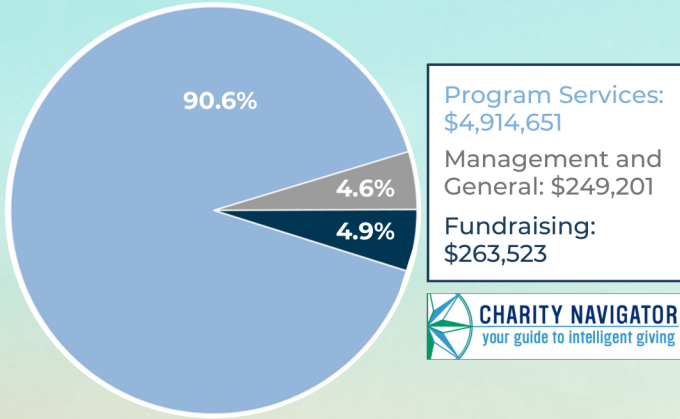

Changed Life Recovery Program

- 70 men sought freedom from addiction
- 8,241 nights of lodging
- 16 program graduates



Faith House

- 42 women received shelter & counsel
- 28 children received shelter & nurture
- 8,105 nights of lodging



Meals & Groceries

- 72, 711 breakfasts and lunches served
- 88,000 individuals received groceries



Outreach

- 42 at-risk children enjoyed Summer Enrichment Camp
- 1,248 joined Bible study
- 1,266 received prayer at lunch or while in line



Learning Center

- 19 residents and volunteers were helped
- 24.23% skill Increase



Rescued Treasures

- 4,288 Individuals clothed
- 94,685 items: clothing, shoes, and bedding



Volunteers

- 1,250 individuals volunteered
- 22,971 hours of volunteerism
