

Changed Life Recovery Program

- 65 men sought freedom from addiction
- 5,586 nights of lodging
- 11 program graduates



Faith House

• 37 women received shelter & counsel



- 28 children received shelter & nurture
- 8,064 nights of lodging

Meals & Groceries

- 98,628 breakfasts and lunches served
- 96.591 people received groceries



Outreach

- 1,245 received prayer at lunch or while in line
- 1,288 joined Bible studies



 65 at-risk children enjoyed Summer Enrichment Camp

Learning Center

- 46 residents, volunteers, and community members were helped
- Studied for GED, ASVAB, job skills, & digital literacy
